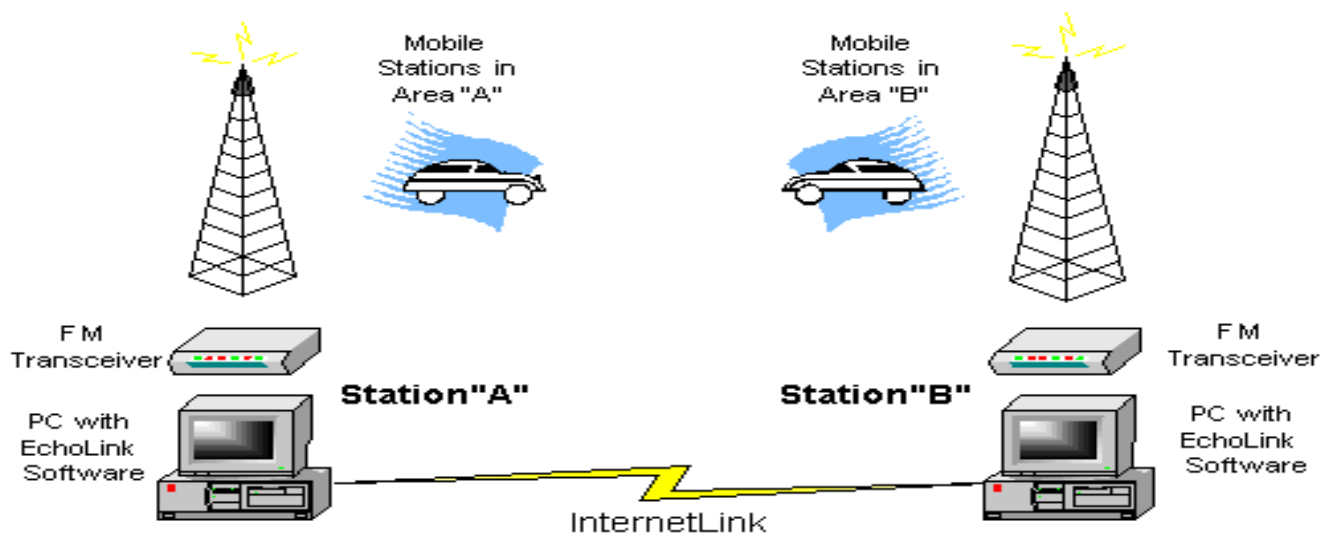


link for P.C. Computers, and EchoMac for Macintosh Computers, are Internet VoIP (Voice over Internet Protocol) technologies. To use either system you must be a radio amateur and provide your call sign before being granted the use of the software required.

Any radio amateur may use his computer, with the required software installed, to access a repeater system based on the Echolink / EchoMac system. The repeater owner can remotely turn on and off the system. Each repeater has a Node number – much like a 4 to 6 digit phone number. A ham operator's computer anywhere in the world can log on to the VoIP system at SCIRA's Snow Peak Repeater site by typing in node number 379885. The radio amateur can also use his handheld transceiver unit in his vehicle or a home based ham radio to access Echolink by a direct radio link to the repeater. Repeaters can be linked when the owner remotely turns on the Echolink system.
