VII. Vice President Report - James L. Dowdle

During a minor or major disaster, landline phones, cell phones and texting may not be working. This condition could last for an extended period of time. Mission Presidents may not be able to contact "their" missionaries because these methods are not working. During an emergency ham radio can provide communication using simplex, repeater or other forms of over the air digital transmission. A ham currently licensed radio operator and one alternate is needed to work directly with each Mission President in the SCIRA, Inc present and future coverage areas. The ham radio operator would report to the Mission President during an emergency. The operator would contact the radio operator(s) over the air in the Stakes for that Mission area. The radio operator would ask for assistance to determine the status of each Missionary in that Stake. They would follow up until the Stake has provided a report. As soon as a Stake report is determined the radio operator would provide that information to the Mission President. The operators should live close to the Mission office. When a major earthquake strikes roads maybe blocked. When a new ham operator assumes the responsibly, they should contact the Mission President as soon as possible to introduce themselves. This maybe best implemented by Area Authorities requesting the Stake Presidents to either ask or extend a church call for the two radio operators. It would be helpful if the radio operators name, address, phone number and email is provided to SCIRA, Inc.

They can be instructed and made aware of radio methods to use during an emergency.

My grandson, Elder Brock Dowdle serving in the Texas, Houston East mission and 5 other Elders were unable to communicate with their Mission President for several days during the hurricane that hit the area late last summer. Their Mission President had an offer from the "Diesel Brothers" (from the TV show of the same name) to go look for them. They found them and transported 4 of them by "Monster Truck" and Elder Dowdle and another Elder in their helicopter back to an area that had phone coverage. They contacted their Mission President and reported that they were safe..
