Repeaters

Eagle Tower 445.700 – Pl 151.4, A 2 meter Winlink system coming soon to this location.

Jobs Peak 146.910 – Pl 151.4, We are in test mode with TASMA and hope to have this finalized soon.

Snow Peak 445.160 – Pl 151.4, We will be changing our link system with Snow Peak and our 2 meter repeater after the ShakeOut. The links could be down for a couple of weeks while we make the changes. – Thanks for your patience.

San Diego 445.940 – Pl 136.5, is on the air and functioning but we need a few more items of work to finish this repeater: batteries and a link radio.

Los Angeles, 445.940 – Pl 151.4, We need a link radio for this location.

Bakersfield, is in the works. We have the solar panels, charger controller, a few radio's and a 440 duplexer for this location. Other equipment is still needed. We are also looking for a good location in the Bakersfield area for this repeater. We along with Fresno, look forward to this project with great anticipation.

Fountain Valley We are looking for a 440 frequency. We are making some inroads here and have some possibilities we are looking into.

Fresno, is in the difficult position of waiting for us to complete Bakersfield before they can link to our Eagle Tower repeater.

Echolink, W6CTR-R on the air. Jared Case launched this week our (W6CTR-L) Echolink station. This runs via solar power. Nice work Jared! Give it a try. We will have W6CTR-R on the two meter Jobs Peak repeater and W6CTR-L on the 440 Snow Peak repeater.

Winlink, We are in the process of installing a 2 meter Winlink station at Eagle Tower. We have a very nice UPS that was originally designed as backup power for stop lights. We have this installed at Eagle Tower and are in the process of learning and installing the Winlink Software.
