What does it take to get a repeater up and running?

First a suitable site needs to secured. Many times a lease has to be arranged. Then frequencies have to be coordinated and approved. Equipment will then need to be ordered and set up at the site. Besides the repeater itself there are many other items that are required to get a repeater on the air. A good antenna, power and back up power, solar panels, batteries, allstar link, duplexer, and a few other nuts and bolts. Plus, the frequencies have to be approved through a frequency coordinator. There is definitely much more involved than connecting the antenna coax and plugging in the power. Besides purchasing the equipment, the repeater sites require monthly rents and we have to purchase insurance



Antenna Spotlight

Near Vertical Incident Skywave (NVIS) Antennas

NVIS design for 80 m



NVIS antennas are for communicating on 40m or 80m out to about 300 miles (500 km). They are quite effective getting a signal out over a mountain top when a repeater isn't available.

The Thursday night net at 8:00 pm on frequency 3.882 Mhz (80 m band) is mainly for testing NVIS antenna designs and Emcomm practice. The net is open to all licensed amateurs who hold a general or above license.

- 2. 78 feet of wire
- 3. 2 Insulators
- 4. 16 feet of paracord
- 5. 15 to 25 foot mast (non-metal)
- 6. 40 feet coax
- 7. Wire winder

A: The repeaters are linked over the internet using Allstar nodes, it takes a few seconds for the network to key up all the repeaters to broadcast your transmission once the repeater receives your signal and the proper PL (CTCSS) code.


